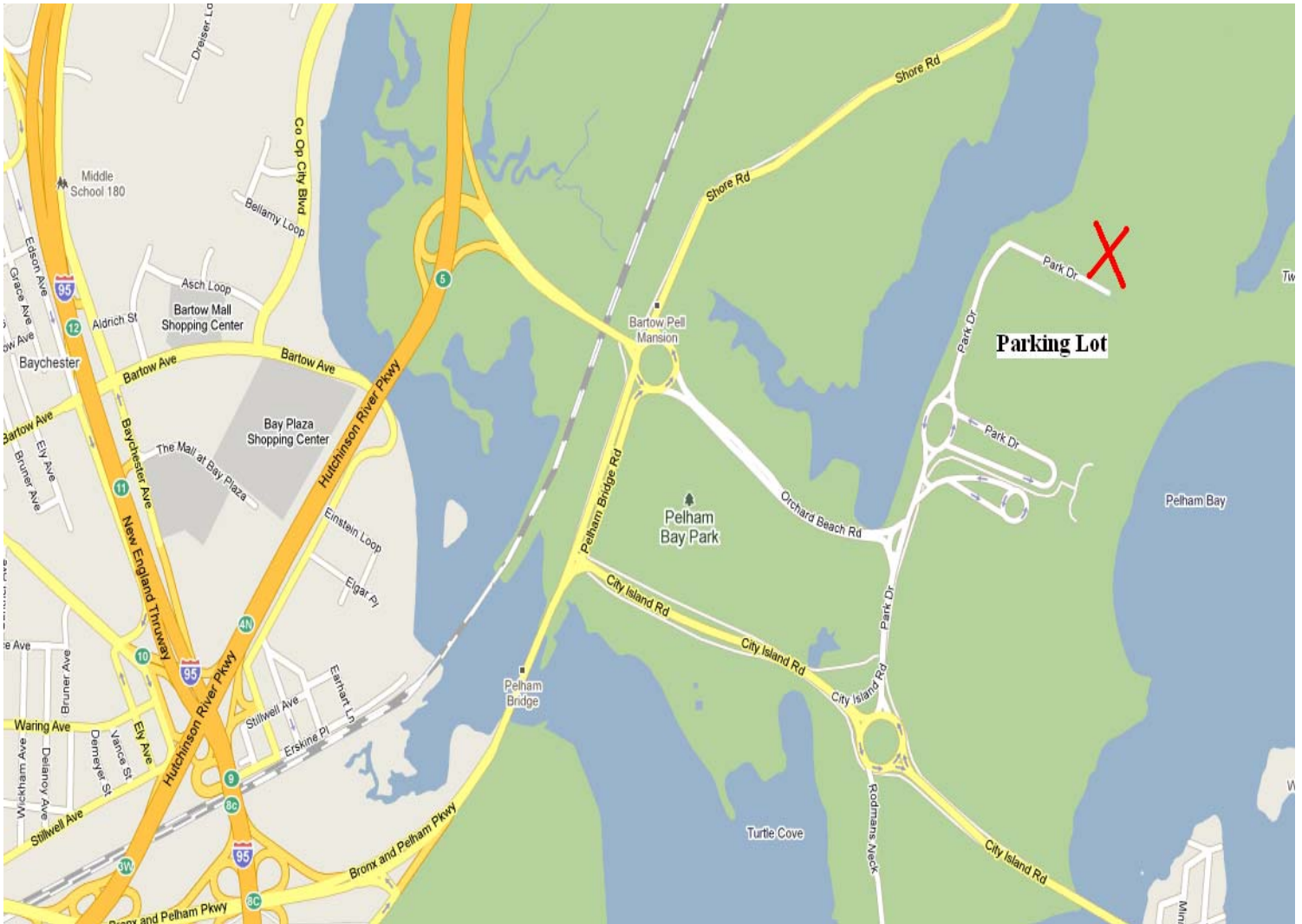


Hunter Island (Pelham Bay Park)



BY CAR: Two major highways provide access from points north and south: The Hutchinson River Parkway and the Bruckner Expressway/New England Thruway combination. Both highways have “Orchard Beach/City Island” exits from either direction. Once you’ve exited, just follow the signs to Orchard Beach. The major cross-town route in The Bronx is Pelham Parkway. Take it eastbound, past the New England Thruway, over the Pelham Bridge, and make a right at the traffic light. At the traffic circle, follow the signs to Orchard Beach.

When you enter the beach facility, drive straight ahead and enter the parking lot by making a right through the toll booths. Make a left after the toll booths. Drive to the top (North) side of the Parking Lot.

TRANSIT: Take 6 train to last stop, Pelham Bay Park. Do not go down the stairs. Instead, walk across the bridge and down the ramp to the park side. There is no bus service to Orchard Beach at this time of year. A Parks Dept. shuttle bus will meet you to drive to Orchard Beach.
